Attendance 17 members of the Parish turned out to hear about the successful year of the Parish Council.

The Chairman welcomed all for attending tonight's meeting and after housekeeping gave a verbal presentation on the timeline of the last year's events from emerging from Covid lockdown, neighbourhood plan meetings to the deposit of the plan to East Suffolk Council. The result of that will not be known until September time. The development of Union Lane North and traffic calming on the Street to issuing dog fouling stickers all work carried out by Parish Councillors.

On Cil (community infrastructure levy) monies have been spent around the Parish on new Benches, Seats, litter bins and three new Parish notice boards all delivered and waiting for the licences to have them installed.
